Philadelphia, PA (November 23, 2009) – The National Constitution Center announces the appointment of **Dr. Stephen Klugewicz** as Director of Education and **Beau Stengel** as Communications Writer.

As Director of Education, **Dr. Stephen Klugewicz** will develop, implement, and evaluate an innovative curriculum-based program of civic education for students and teachers, capitalizing on the Center's unique museum resources and its stature as a national civic forum. This program will serve diverse school audiences regionally, nationally, and internationally.

Prior to joining the Center, Dr. Klugewicz served as served as Director of Education Programs at the Bill of Rights Institute in Arlington, Virginia; Executive Director of the Collegiate Network in Wilmington, Delaware; and Executive Director of The Robert and Marie Hansen Foundation in Oro Valley, Arizona. He has also worked as a consultant to non-profit organizations. Dr. Klugewicz spent seven years teaching at private secondary schools and has taught at the college level. His writing – on history, politics, and classical music – has been published in various academic and popular journals. He has also worked closely with leading American journalists and with national security experts in the Czech Republic.

Dr. Klugewicz earned his M.A. and Ph.D. in American History at the University of Alabama. His academic concentration was eighteenth-century American political and intellectual history. He currently resides in Coatesville, PA.
