NATIONAL CONSTITUTION CENTER WELCOMES SCOTT HOLTZ AS DIRECTOR OF VISITOR SERVICES

Philadelphia, PA (October 1, 2009) – The National Constitution Center announces the appointment of **Scott Holtz** as Director of Visitor Services. Holtz joins the Center from The Leonardo in Salt Lake City, Utah, where he served as Director of Ticketing/Visitor Services.

As Director of Visitor Services, Holtz will ensure the visitor experience at the Center is of the highest quality, and that expectations are exceeded every day for every visitor. In addition, Holtz will oversee the box office and ticketing operations for the Center. Among other duties, he will also be responsible for welcoming and engaging visitors, supervising floor staff, and overseeing the orientation process for groups.

Before joining the Mountain Laurel Center, Holtz worked as Box Office Manager at the Arena at Harbor Yard in Bridgeport, Connecticut; Ticket Operations Project Manager at Princeton University; and Assistant Box Office Manager for Comcast-Spectacor/Global Spectrum in Philadelphia.
